<u>Poster Preparation Guidelines – PTICCS-</u> <u>2025</u>

To ensure uniformity and effective communication of research, all participants presenting posters at the 5th Pak-Turk International Conference on Chemical Sciences (PTICCS-2025) are requested to follow the guidelines below:

1. Poster Size and Format

- Recommended size: Width 1.8 m × Height 1.2 m (Landscape orientation).
- Posters must be printed on **flex/cloth/paper** (as per your preference). Electronic posters will not be accepted.
- Please ensure high-quality printing with clear visibility of text and figures.

2. Poster Layout

- Title Section:
 - ❖ Title of the abstract (same as submitted).
 - ❖ Full names of authors with presenting author underlined.
 - ❖ Affiliation(s), including institution, city, and country.

• Content Sections (suggested):

- o Introduction / Background
- Objectives
- Methodology / Experimental
- * Results and Discussion (figures, graphs, tables encouraged)
- Conclusion
- * References (if necessary)
- Acknowledgements (optional)

3. Text and Font

- Use clear, legible fonts such as Arial, Calibri, or Times New Roman.
- Title: Bold, font size at least 90-150 pt.
- Authors: Bold, font size at least 36-42 pt
- Section headings: Bold, font size at least 36–54 pt.
- **Body text:** Minimum **28-32 pt**, easily readable from 1.5–2 meters.
- Avoid long paragraphs; use bullet points where possible.

4. Figures, Tables, and Graphics

- Ensure all images, charts, and graphs are of **high resolution** (**minimum 300 dpi**).
- Use color contrast effectively (avoid red-green combinations for color-blind readers).
- Each figure/table must include a **caption**.
- Keep visuals as the main focus; balance between text and graphics.

5. Poster Presentation

- Posters should be mounted at the beginning of the conference and remain displayed until the designated poster session ends.
- The presenting author should be available near their poster during the official **poster** session to discuss their work and answer questions.
- Poster code and board number (assigned by organizers) will be communicated in advance.

6. General Tips

- Keep your poster clear, concise, and visually engaging.
- Ensure logical flow from Introduction \rightarrow Methods \rightarrow Results \rightarrow Conclusion.
- Practice a **2–3 minute summary** of your work to share with conference participants.
- Avoid overcrowding with excessive text or too many figures.
